DAILY SESSION SCHEDULE

- Two schools are scheduled to arrive for each Session
- Buses are greeted by Fresh Artists staff and volunteers
- Students, teachers, and chaperones are separated into five groups to be led by a Volunteer Guide throughout the 2-hour program
- Students are escorted into the Cool Jobs Expo event space 15 minutes before the program Session begins
